

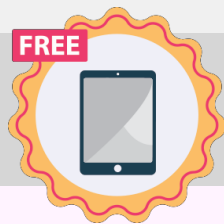


FREE Greek Language Courses for Third Country Nationals

The Greek Language courses are provided in 4 different levels, for persons with no knowledge of Greek up to expert Greek speakers. Each language level will have a duration of 75 hours and is offered on different time schedules, based on the availability of the participants.



A FREE TABLET will be awarded to participants that will attend more than 60% of 1 course and pass the final exam.

Eligibility to participate:

Persons over 18 years of age, with a nationality of a Third Country (non-European Union country nationality) and have one of the following status:

- Third Country National with a student's or worker's or visitor's or Cypriot spouse's residence permit
- Recognized Refugee
- Subsidiary Protection Status
- Asylum Seeker

- help you develop a network of contacts and integrate in the local society
- expand your job opportunities
- help you get acquainted with the practical aspects of daily life
- help you to participate in the civic, cultural and social affairs of Cyprus
